Qualification: For direct recruitment to the cadre of Veterinary Field Assistant (VFA), a candidate shall have to pass HSSLC (Science) with Biology as one of the subjects and also have to complete the one year certificate course in elementary knowledge of Veterinary Science from the recognized school of "School of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry" established by the Govt. of Assam at Ghungoor, Silchar. This is as per Rule 8 of "The Assam Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Subordinate Service (Amendment) Rules, 2017".

Physical Standard: A Candidate for direct recruitment to the cadre of VFA shall be of sound health both mentally and physically and free from any organic defects or body infirmity likely to interfere with efficient performance of his duties and require to undergo medical examination before appointment to the service.
