In compliance of the common order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 22/02/2021 passed in WP(C) No. 5672/2021, Varaha Enterprise and ors. Vs. State of Assam and 2 ors. and it's linked WP(C) No.3015/2021, North Eastern Progressive Pig Farmers Association Vs. Union of India and 2 ors. and as per communication of the Govt. of Assam vide memo no. VFV.269/2020/Pt-II/39 dated 12/04/2021, transportation of live pigs is allowed to North Eastern States through Assam and transportation of only breeding stock (piglets) to Assam for new/revival of pig farms subject to strict adherence to:

- (1) the Standard Operative Procedure(SOP) for transportation of live pigs submitted before the Hon'ble High Court dated 17/02/2021, and notified herewith.
- (2) guidelines and check list for transportation of live pigs prepared in conformity with the said SOP (copies enclosed) and
- (3) all mandates of the Prevention & Control of Infectious and Contagious Diseases in Animals Act,2009.

This order will remain in force until further order.

SOP FOR TRANSPORTATION OF LIVE PIGS

These Standard Operating Procedures for transportation of live pigs through/to Assam is prepared in compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 11/01/2021 passed in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 3015/2020 (North East Progressive Pig Farmers Association Vs. Union of India & 2 ors. and linked Writ Petition (Civil) No. 5672/2020 (Varaha Livestock Enterprise & Anr. Vs State of Assam & 2 ors.

1. Transportation of live pigs may be allowed through Assam by rail as well as by truck from disease free states to neighboring NE states excluding Assam subject to fulfillment of relevant provisions of the "Transport of Animals Rules, 1978", Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960", Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and complying all bio-security measures as per National Action Plan (NAP).
2. Transportation of breeding stock (piglets) may also be allowed to disease free areas of Assam by rail as well as by truck or, the same conditions for new /revival of pig farms.
3. The intended party shall inform to the Officer- in- Charge of the Inter State Border Check Posts, Srirampur, Kokrajhar or Baxirhat, Dhubri at least 72 hours before the entry of the live pig carrying vehicles.. A team of veterinarians in two border Check Posts viz. Boxirhat and Srirampur will be deployed for this purpose.
4. Each consignment of live pigs must have recent Health Certificate (not more than 07 days between testing and loading in wagons or trucks) issued by a competent authority (not below the rank of a registered Government Veterinary Officer). The certificate must incorporate the followings:
 - Identification mark (tagging) of each individual animal.
 - Breed, Age, sex and individual health status of each of the animals.
 - Record of vaccination against classical swine fever and deworming.
 - The transit pigs are originated from ASF free zone.
5. A Transit certificate under Rule 96 of Transport of Animals Rules, 1978 allowing transportation of the animals issued by the competent authority (not below the rank of Assistant Director of A.H. & Veterinary Department of the state having jurisdiction of the place of animal origin) must accompany each consignment from the state/ district of origin indicating
 - Start date of shipment
 - Source and destination point of animals
 - Purpose of transport
 - Number of animals transported
 - Details of sender, transporter and recipient
 - Details of issuing authority of health certificate
6. Based on Sl 4 & 5 above the competent authority in the origin of transit of live pigs will scrutinize and certify.
7. The Government in, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary, Dispur, Guwahati-6 will notify a Cell at the Directorate of A. H. & Veterinary at Chenikuthi, Guwahati-3 for having a Joint control room with personnel from Home, Transport and A.H. & Veterinary who will facilitate transportation of live pigs to and through Assam. The Joint Control Room will work in tandem with the officials deployed at the Inter State Border Veterinary Check Posts.
8. Animals carried by truck etc. will be checked at Inter State Border Check Post situated at Srirampur in Kokrajhaar and Baxirhat in Dhubri district and if required may be quarantined and samples may be collected for random testing (at least 2%) for ASF at NERDDL, Khanapara, Guwahati as and when Government of Assam direct to do so. The expenses for quarantine and testing shall be borne by the transporter/supplier.
9. In case of any animal found to be not fit then those animals will have to be quarantined and the resultant cost of maintenance of the quarantined animals will have to be borne by the supplier or the transporter or the recipient whichever is applicable.

10. In addition to above, the following measures are also to be complied with.

- Respective State Government of the source of live animal should be intimated in writing by the party concerned and the said State Government should inform the Government of Assam that consignment of ASF free live pigs are to be transported through/to Assam.
 - The transit animals shall not be disembarked in any place for any purpose within Assam.
 - The trains do not have any stop over points within Assam unless it is of utmost necessity. Individual accompanying animals including dress should take all sanitary measures.
 - No animal waste or animal carcass is thrown out of the train/truck along the transit route.
 - Local A.H. & Veterinary authority may verify the consignment. In case of death of pigs, the transporter will have to inform the local A.H. & Veterinary officials for proper disposal of carcass.
11. Record of each animal, animal transporter with license number, name of consignee, address of consignee is to be kept at each inter-state check post and is to be forwarded to the Director, of A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam, Guwahati-3.
12. Each vehicle carrying consignment of live pigs will have to be sanitized at the inter-state border of Assam before entry into and exit from Assam (both up and down journey) so that disease does not spread to the other states from Assam. The vehicle should be sanitized at cost of transporter/sender/consignee.
13. Similarly, each wagon carrying consignment of live pigs will have to be sanitized before entry into and exit from Assam at their own cost (both up and down journey) so that ASF does not spread from Assam to the other states.
14. The transporter/ if fails to comply these SOP strictly during and pre and post transportation of live pigs through/to Assam and information of such violation is brought to the notice of the competent authority, the permission granted for the purpose would be cancelled immediately and no further permission will be granted for transportation of pigs/piglets until all the "controlled areas" within Assam are declared "free area" under Section 6(2) of the Prevention and Control of Infectious and Contagious Diseases in Animals Act, 2009.
15. Movement of any vehicle carrying live pigs during night within Assam will not be permitted.
16. This SOP may be reviewed providing reasonable time after notification or any time in exigencies in order to combat ASF in Assam.

**GUIDELINES FOR TRANSPORTATION OF LIVE PIGS IN CONFORMANCE WITH
STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE:**

1. Live pigs may be transported through Assam by rail as well as by truck from disease free states to neighboring NE states excluding Assam subject to fulfillment of relevant provisions of the "Transport of Animals Rules, 1978", Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960", Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and complying all bio-security measures as per National Action Plan (NAP).
2. Breeding stock (piglets) may also be transported from disease free states to disease free areas of Assam by rail as well as by truck on the same conditions **for new /revival of pig farms only. Other than piglets no live pigs will be allowed to unload in Assam.**
3. For transportation of live pigs/breeding piglets through/to the state of Assam, the Health Certificate (Fitness Certificate) is required to be produced from registered Veterinary Officer having jurisdiction over the area of loading as per Rule 87 of Transportation of Animals Rules, 1978. The Copy of Health/Fitness Certificate is enclosed as **Annexure-A.**
4. **In the absence of a Health Certificate, the carrier shall refuse to accept the consignment for transport.**
5. The Transit Certificate as required under Rule 96 of Transportation of Animals Rules, 1978 as amended in 2001) is also to be produced from a Govt. Veterinary Officer not below the rank of Assistant Director having jurisdiction over the area. The Copy of Transit Certificate is enclosed as **Annexure-B.**
6. In addition to Health Certificate and Transit Certificate, the transporter shall have to submit additional information in Form A annexed as Annexure-C.
7. The intended party shall inform to the Officer- in- Charge of the Inter State Border Check Posts, Srirampur, Kokrajhar or Baxirhat, Dhubri at least 72 hours before the entry of the vehicles carrying live pigs through Assam. A team of veterinarians in two border Check Posts viz. Srirampur and Baxirhat will look after be deployed for this purpose.

8. Joint Control Room:

There will be a Joint Control Room at the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary, Assam, Chenikuthi, Guwahati-3. Three officers one each from Home & Political, Transport and A H. & Veterinary Department will be stationed at the Joint Control Room to supervise and facilitate transportation of pigs from other states through/to Assam. The Joint Control Room will work in tandem with the officials deployed at the Inter State Border Veterinary Check Posts (Phone No.7576081893).

9. Animals carried by truck etc. will be checked at Inter State Border Check Post situated at Srirampur in Kokrajhar district and Baxirhat in Dhubri district and in case of transportation by train cheking of animal will be at Srirampur Railway Station and if required may be quarantined and samples may be collected for random testing for ASF at NERDDL, Khanapara, Guwahati as and when Government of Assam direct to do so. The expenses for quarantine and testing shall have to be borne by the transporter/supplier.
10. In any case, if transported pigs need to be quarantined at the quarantine station of Inter State Border Check Post, the following details need to be produced by the transporter in the Inter State Border Check Post:

 - o. Letter from State Government of source to the Government of Assam that consignment of ASF free live pigs are to be transported through/to Assam:
 - p. Reason for quarantine of pigs:
 - q. No. of samples collected and sent for random testing for ASF at NERDDL, Khanapara, Guwahati (protocol for collection and transportation of sample need to be followed):
 - r. Date of collection and sending of samples:
11. In case of any animal found to be not fit then those animals will have to be quarantined and the resultant cost of maintenance of the quarantined animals will have to be borne either by the supplier or the transporter or the recipient as per convenience of the department.
12. In addition to above, the following measures are also to be complied with.
- Respective State Government of the source of live animal should be intimated in writing by the party concerned and the said State Government should inform the Government of Assam that consignment of ASF free live pigs are to be transported through/to Assam.
 - The transit animals shall not be disembarked in any place for any purpose within Assam.
 - The trains should not have any stop over points within Assam unless it is of utmost necessity. Individual accompanying animals including driver should take all sanitary measures.
 - No animal waste or animal carcass is thrown out of the train/truck along the transit route.
 - Local A. H. & Veterinary authority may verify the consignment. In case of death of pigs, the transporter will have to inform the local A. H. & Veterinary officials for proper disposal of carcass.
13. Record of each animal, animal transporter with license number, name of consignee, address of consignee is to be kept at each inter-state check post and is to be forwarded to the Director, of A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam, Guwahati-3.
14. Each vehicle carrying consignment of live pigs will have to be sanitized at the inter-state border of Assam before entry into and exit from Assam (both up and down journey) so that disease does not spread to the other states from Assam. The vehicle should be sanitized at the cost of transporter/sender/consignee.
15. Similarly, each wagon carrying consignment of live pigs will have to be sanitized before entry into and exit from Assam at their own cost (both up and down journey) so that ASF does not spread from Assam to the other states. The place of sanitization for wagon would be at Srirampur Railway Station.
16. The transporter/ if fails to comply the provisions of SOP read with these guidelines during as well as pre and post transportation of live pigs through/to Assam or any of the rules contained in Transport of Animals Rules, 1978 for transport of animals, and if it is pointed out in writing by any officer or persons or Animal Welfare Organization authorized for this purpose by the Animal Welfare Board of India or the Central Government, then, any permit or authorization issued for such transport shall be immediately cancelled by the concerned authority as per rule 97 of the Transport of Animals Rules, 1978 and it shall be the duty of the police to stop the further transport even from the intermediary station and proceed against the said offenders and deal with the animal in accordance with law. No further permission will be granted for transportation of pigs/piglets until all the "controlled areas" within Assam are declared "free area" under Section 6(2) of the Prevention and Control of Infectious and Contagious Diseases in Animals Act, 2009.

17. **Movement of any vehicle carrying live pigs during night within Assam will not be permitted until further notice.**

18. **Identification of consignor and consignee**

- (a) each **consignment shall bear a label** showing in bold red letters the name, address and telephone number (if any) of the consignor and consignee, the number and type of pigs being transported and quantity of rations and food provided to them;
- (b) the consignee and the Officer in charge in Check Gates shall be informed in advance about the train or vehicle in which the consignment of pigs is being sent and its arrival time;

19. **First aid**

In transport of pigs by rail or road –

- (a) first-aid equipment shall accompany the pigs;
- (b) suitable ramps shall be provided for loading and unloading the pigs;
- (c) In the case of a railway wagon, when the loading or unloading is done on the platform the dropped door of the wagon shall be used as a ramp.

20. **Restriction on mixing of different group of pigs**

In transport of pigs by rail or road, male young stock shall not be mixed with female stock in the same compartment.

21. **Padding of food and water**

In transport of pigs by rail or road, sufficient food and fodder shall be carried to last during the journey and watering facility shall be provided at regular intervals.

22. **Padding of floor during travel**

In transport of pigs by rail or road, material for padding, such as straw, shall be placed on the floor to avoid injury if an animal lies down, and this shall be not less than 5 cm thick.

23. **Ban on fettering**

In transport of pigs by rail or road, the animals shall not be fettered unless there is a risk of their jumping out and their legs shall not be tied down.

24. **Space requirement during rail travel**

In transport of pigs by rail –

- (a) no railway wagon shall accommodate more than the number of pigs as specified in the Table below :



- (b) adequate ventilation shall be provided in every wagon and the upper door of one side of wagon shall be kept open and properly fixed and the upper door of the wagon shall have wire gauge closely welded mesh arrangements to prevent burning cinders from the engines the wagon and leading to fire breakout.

25. **Space requirement during road travel**

In transport of pigs by road –

- (a) goods vehicles of capacity of 5 or 4.5 tons, which are generally used for transportation of animals, shall carry not more than twenty pigs;
- (b) in the case of large goods vehicles and containers, partition shall be provided at every two or three metres across the width to prevent the crowding and trapping of pigs;
- (c) in the case of pigs under six weeks of age, separate panels shall be provided.

2. There are no animals which are unfit for transporting such as new born, injured, diseased, blind, emaciated, lame, fatigued animals or those that have given birth during the preceding 72 hours or likely to give birth during transport.
3. Pregnant and young animals are not mixed with other animals during transport.
4. Different classes of animals are not mixed with other animals.
5. Troublesome animals have been given tranquilizers before loading.
6. Provision of feed-fodder, water and milking facilities have been made as follows :
7. The average space provided per cattle in the vehicle is strictly compliant with Rule 50, Tablets I and II (enclosed).

8. Vehicle has ANIMAL CARRIER board clearly visible in Bright Color (having font size of not less than 25 sq cms per letter, is black on yellow background) on both front & back side of the vehicle.

I hereby certify that I have studied and understood the requirements of all the relevant Central and State Acts, rules and orders pertaining to the said animals, including the rule relating to transport of such animals and prevention of cruelty to animals, have been duly complied with.

According to consignor/applicant's statement made in front of me today the animal/animals are not being transported for any purpose contrary to any provision of any law.

If, during any stage of the journey of the vehicle any contravention or non compliance of any of the provisions of the Transport of Animal Rule 1978 and amendments made thereto is noticed and pointed out in writing by any officer or persons or Animal Welfare Organization authorized for this purpose by the Animal Welfare Board of India or the Central Government, then, any permit or authorization issued for such transport shall have immediately to be cancelled by the concerned authority, and it shall be the duty of the police to stop the further transport even from the intermediary station and proposed against the said offenders and deal with the animal in accordance with law.

In all such cases (mentioned in the preceding paragraph), custody of the animals immediately after in all such cases (mentioned in the preceding paragraph), custody of the animals immediately after unloading from the truck or any other vehicle shall have to be given to the authorized Animal Welfare Organization if available, or any other animal welfare organization having the capacity to take the said animals into its care and custody, till the Competent Authority or the Magistrate having jurisdiction decides about their care and upkeep.
