1. Introduction

The State Nodal Agency (SNA), Livestock Health & Disease Control Programme (LH&DCP), Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department (AHVD), Assam intends to engage a Consultant for undertaking Consultancy Service for the Establishment and Management of the Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) in Assam implemented by the State Nodal Agency (SNA), Livestock Health & Disease Control Programme (LH&DCP), Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department, Assam, as defined in the Scope of Work and Other Terms & Conditions mentioned below, through 'Two Bids System'.

2. Estimated work value

The estimated value for Supply of Consultancy Services for the Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) in Assam (2022-23) should not exceed Rs. 24.96 Lakh (Rupees Twenty-Four Lakh Ninety-six Thousand) only. This will be paid from funds released by the Govt. of India for setting up of call centre under NADCP in Assam during 2021-22 vide sanction No. K-11053(5313)/4/2021-LH Dated 30.09.2021.

3. Duration of Engagement

The term / duration of engagement will be valid for a period of 12 (Twelve) Months and shall focus on the Scope of Work mentioned below. The engagement may be extended further on the same Terms and Conditions, as applicable, subject to review by the State Nodal Agency (SNA), Livestock Health & Disease Control Programme (LH&DCP), Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department, Assam.

5. Place of Delivery and Area of Operation

The Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) in Assam shall be housed at the Office of the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam located in the campus of the Institute of Veterinary Biologicals (IVB), Khanapara, Guwahati-22. The area of operation of the SMEC shall be all the 35 districts in the State of Assam.



6. Scope of Work

6.1. Objectives of the SMEC

- (a) The Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP), Assam shall be responsible for monitoring the on ground implementation of NADCP in the state of Assam by calling up beneficiaries (livestock owners) over the telephone and ascertaining vaccination details vis-a-vis their livestock. The SMEC shall work in liaison with the INAPH (Information Network for Animal Productivity and Health) Cell of NADCP in the state with regard to data of the livestock owners (UID and mobile telephone numbers collected during vaccination / ear tagging and registration on INAPH.
- (b) The SMEC shall also call up the on ground/field staff/vaccinators over the telephone and keep record of on ground situations and constraints, if any, faced by the personnels engaged for NADCP in the state. On this front, the SMEC shall liaise with the District Monitoring Units (DMUs) and Block Monitoring Units (BMUs) with regard to data on the on ground/field staff/vaccinators. This shall include collection of daily data on cold chain maintenance.
- (c) The SMEC shall also run telephonic surveys among select groups of general public (e.g. heads of villages, representatives of SHGs, NGOs, Agriculture, Livestock and Dairy Cooperatives etc.) to assess the impact of NADCP and the level of awareness it has rippled among the public in general. For this part, the SMEC shall liaise with the concerned departments of the state government with regard to reaching out to the targeted groups of the general public.
- (d) The data gathered by the SMEC shall be compiled and communicated to the State Nodal Officer (SNO), NADCP, Assam on a day by day basis. The SNO, NADCP, Assam will further communicate the same with the State Monitoring Unit (SMU)/ State Implementing Agency (SIA), NADCP, Assam to assist in making informed decisions at the state level.
- (e) The scope of the SMEC shall not be limited to NADCP only. The SMEC shall be used to survey, monitor and evaluate the performance of other central sector, centrally sponsored and state-level schemes e.g. LH&DC (ASCAD, PPREP, CSFCP), NAIP, NLM, etc. in the state, in liaison with the concerned nodal officers in the state and with appropriation of required manpower. As such, the SMEC shall be running round the year.
- (f) The SMEC shall support the Farmers' Call Centre of the State Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Department as and when required. The Department may set up appropriate mechanism to be established within the SMEC to support the Kisan Call Centre of the Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Department, Assam, in liaison with concerned sectoral officers of the Department in the state and with appropriation of required manpower.
- (g) However, SMEC shall not serve as the Call Centre for managing the operations of the ESVHD-Mobile Veterinary Units (ESVHD-MVU). Under the provisions of the ESVHD-MVU scheme, a dedicated independent Call Centre for managing the operations of ESVHD-MVU shall be established by the A. H. & Veterinary Department.

6.2. Terms of Reference

The controller of administration and management of the Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme in Assam (SMEC, NADCP, Assam) shall be the Director cum CEO, SNA, LH&DCP, A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam.

The SMEC, NADCP, Assam shall, in general, be working during office hours on all working days of the Office of the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam. The Director cum CEO, LH&DCP, A. H. &

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Veterinary Department, Assam may notify any special working schedule for the SMEC, NADCP, Assam in special circumstances with appropriation for required manpower and equipment.

The successful bidder shall undertake the following with respect to the Supply of Consultancy Services for the Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) in Assam.

- Assist the State Nodal Officer, NADCP to oversee the establishment of the Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) in Assam at the designated housing location, as stated in the section stating the place of delivery and area of operation (Section 5. of the bid document) with technical inputs.
- Assist the State Nodal Officer to oversee the supply of the hardware, equipment & furniture required for the SMEC and their installation, testing and commissioning at the designated housing location within the specified period of delivery / engagement with technical inputs.
- 3. The hardware, equipment & furniture supplied and installed in the Survey, Monitoring and Evaluation Cell (SMEC) Call Centre under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) in Assam shall be the property of the A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam designated for exclusively used for the purpose of the SMEC. The successful bidder shall operate/use the said hardware, equipment & furniture during the specified period of engagement under the purview of the SMEC, NADCP, Assam.
- 4. The successful bidder shall assist the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam in overseeing and managing the day to day operations of the SMEC, NADCP, Assam with expert inputs.
- 5. To achieve the objectives of the SMEC, NADCP, Assam the successful bidder shall be responsible for the contractual engagement and management of at least 3 (three) nos. of skilled persons on service operator staff roles and 1 (one) consultant epidemiological data analyst cum data communication expert on supervisory role under the purview of the SMEC, NADCP, Assam.
- 6. The cost towards the remuneration / professional fee of the human resources engaged in the SMEC, NADCP, Assam shall be paid to the successful bidder as per the approved rates at the end of every calendar month against monthly bills certified by the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam or any other competent authority designated by the Director cum CEO, SNA, LH&DCP, A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam.
- 7. The contractual service staff of the SMEC, NADCP, Assam shall call up the beneficiaries, field staff/vaccinators, and the members of select groups of general public, as required, over the telephone and keep the data of the calls for the preparation of the daily progress report based on the collected data under the supervision of the liaison officers designated by the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam. This shall include collection of daily data on cold chain maintenance.
- 8. All telephonic calls made from and to the SMEC, NADCP, Assam shall be kept recorded with the help of the call logger units and stored for future records and verification purpose.
- Data collection, management, reconciliation, analysis and relevant technical operations of the SMEC, NADCP, Assam shall be the done under the supervision of the epidemiological data analyst cum data communication expert in liaison with the concerned nodal officers. Development and implementation of necessary forms, tool-kits for data collection and analytics etc. shall be done under the supervision of the data analysis expert. The analytics expert shall assist the SIA, NADCP, Assam in making informed decisions at the state-level.
- The deliverables under the Consultancy Service for the SMEC, NADCP, Assam include the following:
 - (a) Spatio-temporal analysis on vaccination coverage of Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) & Brucellosis on susceptible population at village level.
 - (b) Risk analysis on FMD/Brucellosis outbreak in epi-units based on FMD & Brucella vaccination coverage.
 - (c) Impact assessment on the awareness rising in terms of vaccination, tagging & animal registrations etc. for implementation of NADCP and develop an effective IEC/vaccination
 - (d) Module to create / improve responsiveness of the farmers to the highest level to achieve
 - (e) The Supportive Supervision Consultant will interact with the value addition of ear tagging, animal registration process in INAPH platform, vaccination process at Block, Village and Door to Door level to achieve the desired goal. State Nodal Officer

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- (f) Impact assessment analysis up to beneficiaries' level of different ongoing central sector and centrally sponsored schemes in the A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam.
- 11. For every working day, one liaison officer on roster basis shall be designated by the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam to supervise and oversee the daily affairs of SMEC. The designated liaison officer shall be responsible for the compilation of daily data gathered by the SMEC in the form of a daily progress report and submission of the same to the State Nodal Officer, NADCP, Assam by the end of the day in liaison with the technical team of SMEC.
- 12. To use SMEC for other schemes, the same operating mechanism may be followed, liaising with the nodal offices of the respective schemes. In that case, liaison officers shall be designated by the concerned nodal officers of the scheme concerned.
- Other relevant matters as entrusted by the Director cum CEO, SNA, LH&DCP, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department, Assam.

6.3. Technical and Logistics Terms & Conditions

- 1. Except the data collected directly by the SMEC, NADCP, Assam through its service operator staff, other data required for performing the tasks to achieve the deliverables mentioned in the Scopes of Work will be shared in standard machine-readable formats (e.g. Spread Sheets / Excel format) with the Consultant by the AHVD.
